



CAFM/CAPA Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Declaration Form

It is important to ensure that you remain within the maximum hours that can be earned in one year in each category. This is outlined in AFOA's CAFM/CAPA MOC Record Keeping Instructions. *For example, if you are the Chair on multiple Boards, you may only claim a maximum of 20 hours for all Boards (10 hours if you are a Director); if you are enrolled in 3 courses, you may only claim the maximum of 20 combined hours for all courses, etc. Please call AFOA if you require assistance in determining what hours are required.*
